7. Initiate/Schedule your next propane delivery.
8. Upon settling in, you'll want to research all the versatile appliances that can also run on propane. Backyard entertaining can be enhanced with decorative outdoor lighting, outdoor hearths, fire pits and grilling.
9. Does your new home come with a wood-burning fireplace? You might consider replacing it with a propane hearth; clean and convenient, it lights with the simple press of a button. No more wood chopping, wood storage, wood-sparking fire hazards, or messy clean ups.
