#2 - Belleze 48,000BTU Premium Patio Heater, Propane, CSA Certified

The heat range is maximized at 15 feet radius. The heater comes with anti-tilt automatic shut-off mechanism and is sturdy with a steel construction. Use the ignite button to turn it on. It is available in different colors such as Hammer Bronze, Hammer Black, Mocha, and Stainless Steel.

#3 - Fire Sense Commercial Patio Heater

Typically seen at restaurants, this propane heater packs a punch with 46,000 BTU's of heating power and a heating range up to 18'.

BestReviews says: Once properly assembled, this patio heater nicely heats up the surrounding area. Pros: Strong heat output and heavy duty construction easily separate this heater from the rest. Cons: Not as effective in slight to moderate wind.

#4 - XtremepowerUS 48,000 BTU Premium Floor Standing Propane Outdoor Patio Heater

This heater features a shut-off tilt valve that turns the heater off automatically if tipped over. A wheel assembly with two smooth-rolling wheels is included, making it easy to transport the outdoor heater from poolside to patio or from one side of the deck to the other. An easy push of the button lights the heater with one-step Piezo ignition system. Variable-heat control knob allows for low or high heat settings and for turning the heater completely off at the end of the night.

BestReviews says: Offers ample heating ability at a reasonable price. Worth considering in spite of a few concerns. Pros: Easy to assemble and effective at heating most patio areas with its 48,000 btu. Ample power for a mid-level price. Cons: Ignition sometimes takes several attempts to light. Bottom has little weight which makes it easy to tip over.

Made of high-quality materials, it is expected to last for a long period of time. Wheels make it much easier to carry around. An easy-access door for propane means easier maintenance for your tank. The heater provides a fair amount of heat and a nice look for lawns.
